

PETITION TO THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE AND ITS PLANNING AND DESIGN REVIEW BOARDS

The undersigned are residents of Central Contra Costa County who oppose the planned development of the scenic ridge adjacent to the Acalanes Ridge Open Space, which overlooks Acalanes High School and Secluded Valley.

The proposed development by the Haji interests will permanently scar and alter the habitat of the East Face of the scenic ridge, which is a dominant viewpoint and one of the last remaining accessible open spaces east of Pleasant Hill Road. This development will create a severe impact on wildlife, restrict hiking access, and seriously impair the views of numerous homes in the County, Lafayette and Walnut Creek.

We request that the development be rejected, and serious consideration be given to reinforcing the conservation of this scenic treasure. At a minimum, an environmental impact report should be required and public hearings conducted in each jurisdiction.
